Instructions to Students

The Post-Foundation English Final Exams are scheduled for Sunday, 22nd January 2023. The details are given in the table below.

To take the exam, follow the instructions given below:

- Bring your college ID card. If you do not have one, bring any ID that includes your picture (e.g. local resident identification, passport, driving license). Student who do not have an ID are NOT allowed to take the Final Exam. Photocopies of IDs and pictures of IDs on mobile phones are not acceptable. Similarly, no notes from any source (e.g. Course Teachers, Advisors, Student Affairs) will be accepted to allow students with no ID cards to take the Final Exam.
- Also, bring your stationery (e.g pencil, rubber) with you. Exchanging or sharing stationery is NOT allowed.
- Report to the exam room **10 minutes before** the exam starts.
- If you report to the exam room after the exam has started, you will NOT be given any **extra time**. In fact, **NO** extra time will be given to you **for any reason**.
- You may use a pen or a pencil to write the exam. However, your writing must be clear enough to be read.
- Do not open the exam paper until you are instructed to do so.
- Use of mobile phones, Bluetooth, smart watches, and dictionaries in the examination room is **NOT** allowed.
- Cheating / malpractice in any form will be considered as a serious offence. If you are found to be involved in malpractice or cheating of any nature during the Final Exam, you will **NOT** be allowed to continue taking the exam and will be instructed to leave exam room.
- You are allowed to leave the exam room after 30 minutes from the commencement of the exam.

Listening Exam guidelines:

- 1. After answering **Section 1** (**Reading**), the invigilator will **NOT** collect the papers.
- 2. Then you will first receive the Note-taking Form where you have to write your notes while listening.
- 3. The Note-taking Form is a back-to-back paper (to be used for BOTH Listening 1 and Listening 2).
- 4. Write your full name and ID on the form, and get ready for **Listening1** and taking notes.
- 5. Once the recording is played, start taking notes.
- 6. You will listen to the recording **twice**.

- 7. While listening to the recording for the second time, finalize your notes.
- 8. You will receive the Listening1 Question Paper, do not open it until you are instructed to do so.
- 9. **Once instructed,** write your name and ID on the Question Paper.
- 10. You will be given 8 minutes to read the questions and answer using your notes.
- 11. You must write your answers on the Question Paper.
- 12. Once you hear "That's the end of Listening 1", you have to stop writing.
- 13. The invigilator will NOT collect the papers.
- 14. Now, flip the Note-Taking Form over to be able to write notes for Listening 2 questions. You will not get a new Note-Taking Form for Listening 2.
- 15. Once the recording is played, start taking notes.
- 16. You will listen to the recording **twice**.
- 17. While listening to the recording for the second time, finalize your notes.
- 18. You will receive the Listening2 Question Paper, do not open it until you are instructed to do so.
- 19. **Once instructed,** write your name and ID on the Question Paper.
- 20. You will be given 8 minutes to read the questions and answer using your notes.
- 21. You must write your answers on the Question Paper.
- 22. Once you hear "That's the end of Listening 2", you must stop writing.
- 23. The invigilator will NOT collect your Listening papers.
- 24. The Listening exam papers will be collected at the end of the entire exam.
